UBIC Obtains Notifications of Allowance for Two Korean Patents for Its Al-Based Technology Called "Landscaping"

Establishing a Stronger Presence in the Asian Market

TOKYO, Dec. 2, 2015 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- <u>UBIC</u>, Inc. (Nasdaq:UBIC) (TSE:2158) ("UBIC" or "the Company"), a leading provider of international litigation support and big-data analysis services, today announced that the Korean Intellectual Property Office recently issued two Notifications of Allowance to the Company for patent applications related to "Landscaping", a technology associated with UBIC's Al engine called "KIBIT". This new technological function is a manifestation of UBIC's innovative concept called "Behavior Informatics".

The necessary procedures for patent registration have already been executed, and the patent is currently pending issuance. UBIC has previously obtained a Japanese patent for this system (patent registration number: 5567049; registration date: June 27, 2014; patent registration number: 5526209; registration date: April 18, 2014), so the Korean patent approval marks the expansion of UBIC's IP protection for this technology into a second country.

"Landscaping", a unique, AI-related technology developed by UBIC, is an integrated hallmark of UBIC's AI engine called KIBIT. As part of the Company's core technology, Landscaping facilitates the retrieval of desired information from clusters of big data. For example, Landscaping allows KIBIT to acquire expert knowledge from training data which is created by users, and the attributes of the training data helps KIBIT to learn how to find information matching the users' intentions in each specific case. When there is insufficient training data to ensure the desired results for our users, KIBIT employs its relearning algorithms to quickly adjust its assessments and boost performance.

The two Korean patent approvals mark the expansion of UBIC's IP protection for KIBIT's core technology into a second country Landscaping and KIBIT are being applied in the field of eDiscovery to improve Predictive Coding, a method which makes document review dramatically easier by having the AI acquire and utilize the tacit knowledge of attorneys to automatically categorize enormous amounts of data.

UBIC's Intellectual Property Activities:

UBIC places particular emphasis on protecting its intellectual property. The Company has safeguarded the unique brand identity it has created over the years by developing innovative, cutting-edge technologies and services related to data analysis and providing these to an expanding, worldwide client base. As of September 4, 2015, no less than 79% of its patents have been filed in foreign countries. It is an important goal for UBIC to expand and strengthen the competitive position in Asia for its big data analysis business, and international litigation support is a key component of this goal. Thus, the Company will continue to develop and defend its IP rights across Asia.
