UBIC and BI.Garage Form an Alliance to Launch the First SNS Marketing Support Service in Japan to Use Artificial Intelligence

NEW YORK, Sept. 7, 2015 (GLOBE NEWSWIRE) -- UBIC, Inc. (Nasdaq:UBIC) (TSE:2158) ("UBIC" or "the Company"), a leading provider of Al-based, big data analysis services, and Bl.Garage, Inc. ("Bl.Garage") announced today that they have formed a business alliance to provide a social networking site (SNS) marketing support service that combines Bl.Garage's expertise in social media marketing and UBIC's artificial intelligence (AI) technology. This will be the first AI-based SNS marketing support service in Japan.

Initially, BI.Garage will equip Tweetmanager, a Twitter account operation support tool that it has developed and provided since 2009, with a new function to work in collaboration with UBIC's Virtual Data Scientist (VDS) and related technologies. VDS technology allows Tweetmanager to quickly analyze the massive volume of text posted on Twitter. Companies using Tweetmanager will be able to analyze their marketing strategies by reviewing and incorporating the information provided by VDS related to Twitter users. Companies with access to this user information will be able to make more effective business actions.

As a result of increased use of SNS in recent years, many companies and organizations have been attracted by the marketing potential of SNS, and are operating SNS accounts through various platforms, such as Twitter. Meanwhile, since processing and analyzing the huge volume of text data available on SNS requires a tremendous amount of time and expense as well as knowledge and experience, there are practical limits to using SNS accounts for marketing purposes. This new collaboration between Tweetmanager and VDS will make it possible to identify valuable data found in tweets, which contain information that can enhance marketing initiatives, and to use the collected data to post messages that increase the engagement rate between users and companies.

In the future, BI.Garage and UBIC hope to strengthen their alliance and will continue to cooperate in the development of systems and services in the social media field, including the development of a system to automatically audit tweets and notify corporate social media account operators of messages that could pose a risk to their operations.

Tweetmanager

Tweetmanager is a Twitter account operation tool that supports companies and organizations operating Twitter accounts in their marketing activities by facilitating smooth operation and management of Twitter accounts and by measuring the effects of the activities.

VDS

VDS is an Al-based program that performs such intellectual tasks as identifying and sorting necessary information from among the mass of information. Under the U.S. legal discovery system, which requires disclosure of evidence in litigation cases, it is necessary to find emails and document data containing relevant evidence from among a huge volume of electronic data in a prescribed period of time. As the volume of electronic data continues to grow year after year, the approach of relying primarily on manpower, including lawyers, to perform the process of data review has approached its limits. Moreover, the necessary data varies from case to case depending on the nature of the case (patent infringement, anti-trust, etc.) and the circumstances of the company involved. UBIC has tackled these challenges and has succeeded in developing AI technology which incorporates human professionals' tacit knowledge, including experience and intuition, which excels in flexibility and calculation efficiency and which is well-suited for making future projections.

Bl.Garage, Inc.

Bl. Garage, Inc. is a data science business joint venture that Digital Garage, Inc. established together with Dentsu Inc., Cyber Communications Inc. and Asatsu-DK Inc. It provides Tweetmanager, a Twitter account operation tool.
