FRONTEO Launches Knowledge Probe 20, An Al-Based Business Data Analysis Support System with a Function for Highlighting Key Locations

System Further Enhances Efficiency of Analysis Results Review and Accuracy Assessment

TOKYO, October 1, 2019 - FRONTEO, Inc. ("FRONTEO") (NASDAQ: FTEO) (TSE: 2518) a leading provider of artificial intelligence ("AI") based big data analysis services, announced today that it launched Knowledge Probe 20 (KP 20), a new AI-based business data analysis support system. KP 20 is equipped with KIBIT G2, the next-generation version of FRONTEO's independently developed AI engine KIBIT. It enables faster review of analysis results through the addition of features such as a function for highlighting key locations that influence scores.

Knowledge Probe (KP), a business analysis support system that uses AI learned in experts' evaluation criteria to analyze vast quantities of text data, has a wide range of applications, from analysis of daily business reports and customer feedback to HR-related tasks such as preventing employee turnover and analysis of job applications. Since analysis results are provided using a scoring system that ranks text in order of similarity to the training data, reviews can be conducted by starting from the texts with the highest scores, making it possible to comprehensively and efficiently identify the desired data.

Until now, when using KP, it was difficult to know which specific sections of the data contributed to a text's high score, especially when analyzing data in lengthy documents. Feedback from users indicated that it was time-consuming to verify long texts and also difficult to explain the results to others. To resolve these issues and make the review process simpler and more efficient, KP 20 is equipped with a new highlighting function.

Simplifying Reviews and Accuracy Assessment Using Highlighting Function

It is possible to highlight sections of analyzed data that have a strong impact on the score (divided based on punctuation or line feed code) as key locations. This will reduce the number of man-hours spent on review and accuracy assessment substantially when analyzing data with a large number of characters.

Other Functional Improvements and Changes

- Enabling seamless analysis results verification even for large amounts of data
 - Enabled seamless and effortless verification of analysis results on the KP 20 screen through means such as exporting the results as a CSV file even in the case of vast amounts of data



- Changes to the user environment
 - Eliminated the need to install Silverlight (change to HTML5)
 - <u>Cloud version</u>: Abolished login via Citrix and enabled direct login to KP 20
- Compatibility with more browsers
 - Expanded compatibility from one browser (Internet Explorer) to three browsers: Internet Explorer, Google Chrome (recommended), and Microsoft Edge.
- <u>Compatibility with parallel processing across multiple servers</u>
 - Enabled set up for parallel processing across multiple servers based on customer preferences and total amount of data since the system is equipped with KIBIT G2.

Going forward, FRONTEO will continue supporting customers by helping them perform their work in a more efficient, sophisticated manner by providing various solutions that leverage its expertise in natural language processing technology and KP 20.

KIBIT is an AI engine developed by FRONTEO. KIBIT is a word coined by combining "kibi," a Japanese word meaning "subtlety," and "bit," the smallest unit of digital information, in order to indicate an AI capable of understanding the subtle elements of human behavior and personality.
